CALL FOR APPLICATIONS JOIN THE YOUNG EUROPEANS JURY!

A COMMITTED JURY

Made up of 7 students from 17 to 25 years old, this jury gathers young Europeans who are interested in history and European issues, and awards a prize to the best documentary in the section *European Stories*, composed of ten European films.

Gathered in Biarritz for a week, they exchange their points of view and open up to the world.

In 2021, the jury awarded Alexander Nanau's film Collective, nominated for an Oscar in the categories «Best Documentary» and «Best International Film».

AN EXCEPTIONAL OPPORTUNITY

The Young Europeans Jury is a unique opportunity for students from different backgrounds and cultures: the selection is unique for its openness, its awareness and its debates possibilities.

Thanks to documentaries, these students make Europe young again.

During a week, they will be able to:

- ▼ Think about various European issues through the prism of cinema
- Open their minds to different European cultures within a multicultural jury
- Develop their critical thinking and argumentation skills

COMPOSITION OF THE JURY

The Young Europeans Jury is composed of:

- Five young people from the Nouvelle Aquitaine region partners
- ▼ A high school student from Nouvelle Aquitaine (representing France)
- A student from the group of countries invited: Benelux in 2022 (Belgium, Netherlands, Luxembourg).

In total, 7 students with diverse backgrounds and origins are gathered, to elevate and enrich the debate. The proposed framework of emulation is extraordinarily generous for the students, who will be nourished by different experiences and cultures.

- Come to Biarritz and be available from 17 to 23 January 2022
- Attend all screenings of the films in the Histoires d'Europe competition.
- Participate in the deliberation and defend your
