Each shelter is highlighted by a marker which, when clicked, shows information gathered from a database we made by using MySQL. This will become the core of our website which will also contain other historical information about Bologna during World War II.

The library you published was very intuitive and easy to use, so we didn't find any issues that

we couldn't solve by ourselves or using the documentation you provided on the Leaflet website. We are very grateful for the materials you shared as it has made our little project much easier to be implemented.
